(If you are currently enrolled with another organization first click on "Change Organization.") 5) Click on "Enroll" in the Calvary Episcopal Church box. 6) That's it! Once you are enrolled, use your Kroger Plus Card, or enter your Alternate ID (phone number associated with the card), every time you shop at Kroger and help generate funds for Calvary.
